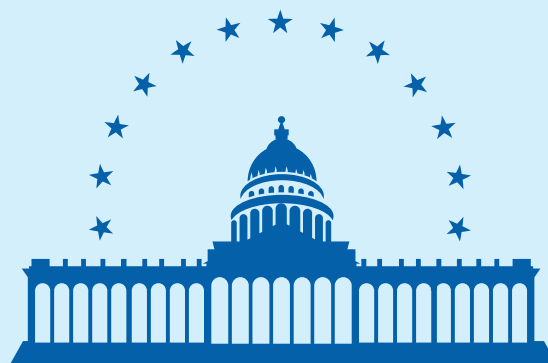




Supporting and increasing research funding for renewable energy
