## **Photo Policy**

The American Society for Biochemistry and Molecular Biology encourages chapters to submit photos of chapter activities, including chapter and regional meetings and outreach events, among others. The society uses these photos on its website, in print materials and on social media accounts to promote the ASBMB Student Chapters program. However, the ASBMB requires chapters to adhere to the following guidelines when submitting photos.

- I. Consent to use the photo must be obtained in writing from the photographer. Chapters may use the photography consent form on page two or ask the photographer to give consent through email. The written consent (form or email) must accompany the photograph when submitting to the ASBMB.
- 2. The ASBMB strongly prefers that chapters receive written consent from all people in the photograph as well.
- 3. Chapters wishing to submit photos of students under the age of 18 must submit to the ASBMB a photography consent form (page two) signed by a parent or guardian for each minor pictured in the photo.
- 4. Chapters also must follow their institutions' guidelines regarding photography submissions when submitting pictures to the ASBMB.
